Tourism in the Province of Belluno (year 2022)

In the period January-December 2019, arrivals in the province of Belluno amounted to 1,028,261. In the same period in 2021 there were 734,160 arrivals, a number that rose to 981,149 in 2022. We can therefore see a sharp decrease in arrivals in 2021 compared to 2019, which should be read considering the curb on departures due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Already in 2022, the flow of arrivals in the province rose compared to 2021, approaching pre-pandemic levels.

In the period January-December 2019, arrivals in the province of Belluno totalled 3,744,708. In the same period in 2021, 2,848,056 presences were recorded, rising to 3,398,194 in 2022. We can, therefore, note a more pronounced decrease in presences than in arrivals between 2021 and 2019, to be analysed in light of the curb imposed by the Covid-19 pandemic. In 2022, there is an increase in presences compared to 2021. Again, the level of presences in 2022 did not reach pre-pandemic levels.

Considering tourist arrivals by origin (percentage weight) in the Province of Belluno:

- In 2019, 44.0% of arrivals was represented by foreign tourists and 56.0% by Italians
- In 2021, 27.6% of arrivals was represented by foreign tourists and 72.4% by Italians
- In 2022, 42.1% of arrivals was represented by foreign tourists and 57.9% by Italians

Considering tourist arrivals by type of accommodation facility (% weight) in the Province of Belluno:

- In 2019 37.4% of arrivals was in extra-hotel structures and 62.6% in hotel structures
- In 2021 40.9% of arrivals was in extra-hotel structures and 59.1% in hotel structures
- In 2022 38.6% of arrivals was in non-hotel structures and 61.4% in hotel structures
