Tourism in the province of Treviso (year 2022)

In the period January-December 2019 arrivals in the province of Treviso amounted to 1,008,260. In the same period in 2021 there were 476,828 arrivals, a number that rose to 736,648 in 2022. We can therefore see a sharp decrease in arrivals in 2021 compared to 2019, which should be read considering the curb on departures due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Already in 2022, the flow of arrivals in the province has risen compared to 2021, although still not reaching pre-pandemic levels.

In the period January-December 2019, the number of presences in the province of Treviso was 2,225,936. In the same period in 2021 there were 1,371,502 presences, rising to 1,628,388 in 2022. We can, therefore, see a more pronounced decrease in presences than in arrivals between 2021 and 2019, to be analysed in light of the curb imposed by the Covid-19 pandemic. In 2022, there is an increase in admissions compared to 2021. Again, the level of presences in 2022 did not reach pre-pandemic levels.

Considering tourist arrivals by origin (percentage weight) in the Province of Treviso:

- In 2019, 54.0% of arrivals was represented by foreign tourists and 46.0% by Italians
- In 2021, 32.7% of arrivals was represented by foreign tourists and 67.3% by Italians
- In 2022, 44.1% of arrivals was represented by foreign tourists and 55.9% by Italians

Considering tourist arrivals by type of accommodation facility (% weight) in the Province of Treviso:

- In 2019 22.3% of arrivals was in extra-hotel structures and 77.7% in hotel structures
- In 2021 32,5% of arrivals was in extra-hotel structures and 67,5% in hotel structures
- In 2022 28.6% of arrivals was in non-hotel structures and 71.4% in hotel structures
